

PHORIDAE (DIPTERA, CYCLORRHAPHA)  
FROM THE AZORES AND MADEIRA<sup>1</sup>

*Megaselia (Aphiochaeta) pleuralis* Wood.

Azores: Faial: Praia do Almoxarife, 31.III. (Loc. 72). 1 ♀.

The species is new to the island of Faial, but previously recorded from the islands São Miguel and Pico, whole Europe, Iceland and Canada by Frey (Soc. Scient. Fenn., VIII., 10, 1944).

*Megaselia (s.s.) rufipes* Meig.

Azores: São Miguel: Valley of Ribeira Quente, 2 km SE of Furnas, 11.III. (Loc. 23). 1 ♂.

Faial: Praia do Almoxarife, 31.III. (Loc. 72). 1 ♂.

Cosmopolitan species, recorded from the Azores by Frey (*loc. cit.*).

*Megaselia (s.s.) marina* Schmitz

Madeira: Funchal, Ribeiro Seco, coast, 25.IV. (Loc. 126). 1 ♂.

Recorded from the Azores, Madeira and the Islands of the Gulf of Marseille by Frey (*loc. cit.*).

*Megaselia (s.s.) ardua* Schmitz

Azores: São Miguel: 1.5 km S of Maia, 25.IV (Loc. 62). 1 ♂.

Recorded from Madeira and the Azores by Frey (*loc. cit.*).
